

# The logo

The logo is an important part of a visual identity and it is the first element that people connect with the laboratory.

Formats EPS/AI are vector formats: a mathematical string of commands indicating direction, colour, width, etc. You can drag and resize EPS and AI formatted graphics to any size, from a post-card to a 10 m2 advertisement billboard, and maintain the quality of the logo or graphic intact.

TIFF/ JPEG are "rasterized" images with a specific pixel size that cannot be enlarged without losing design details.



## The colours

Skel logo colour palette consists of 1 grey and 1 blue :

Grey: PANTONE 425c

Blue: PANTONE Process Blue C

These colours are used in the logo prints. PANTONE is a worldwide colour specification and recognition system. Pantone colours are also referred to as spot colours, PMS or special colours.

RGB is a colour system consisting of Red, Green and Blue. The RGB system is used for reproducing colours on screen. HTML/HEX codes are based on the RGB system.

CMYK is a colour printing system in which the colours are separated into four printable colours: Cyan, Magenta, Yellow and Key colour (black). In the case of 4-colour print we shall always use the CMYK value codes to reproduce our corporate colours.
